#### SO WHAT DO I NEED FROM YOU, SUPER CREW MATE AND ALL-AROUND AWESOME PERSON?



"Uh...what are you doing?" asked Upper Crustacean, clearly surprised.


"I'm tired of this," answered NarWall. "I can't keep fighting you forever."
